2018-2019 ILLINOIS HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

All students playing sports, dance and cheer teams, and any new students transferring in from out-of- state will need a physical exam. All new students entering an Illinois school for the first time will require an eye exam.

All Preschool, Kindergarten, and new students will need a copy of their birth certificate.

Immunizations:

- As a quick reference they need the following with most requiring a booster after the age of 4: (4) Dtap; (3) Polio; (2) MMR; (2) Varicella; (3) Hep B., Pneumococcal and Hib are not required after age of 5. They are required for pre-school along with a physical every two years. Call Nurse Dana at South School at (217) 826-5411 for more specific information for pre-school.

2ND Meningitis (unless your child did not receive the 1st booster until after age 16, then just 1 one is required.

- **Note on Varicella** This year (2018-2019) all grades will require 2 doses except for 5th grade. Fifth grade will require 2 doses next school year as well.
- **Note on** Meningitis—This year (2018-2019) 6th through 9th grades need 1 dose; 12th grade needs 2 doses or 1 after their 16th birthday.
